## REMINDER TO FILE 2017 INCOME TAX RETURN

Dear Resident/Family Member or Financial Representative:

This reminder letter is being sent to all residents residing in a residential care facility funded by Fraser Health, or to the person managing the resident's financial matters. If the 2017 income tax return has been filed with Canada Revenue Agency, then you may disregard this letter.

Income information from your 2017 Notice of Assessment from Canada Revenue Agency is used to calculate your residential rate for January 1, 2019. To be eligible for a subsidized residential rate the resident, and where applicable the resident's spouse, is required to file a yearly income tax return.

This letter is a reminder to file the resident's 2017 income tax return. If the 2017 income tax return has been filed, please disregard this reminder, as no further action is required at this time.

Residents who have **not** filed a 2017 income tax return to Canada Revenue Agency by July 31, 2018 may be charged the maximum monthly subsidized residential rate effective <u>January 1, 2019</u>. The maximum rate is set yearly by the Ministry of Health Services and will be in excess of \$3,278.80.
