



Menno Place is BC's largest campus-of-care with 11.5 acres, 6 buildings, 700 residents, 250 volunteers and 620 full, part-time and casual staff.

Three of the buildings (Pavilion, Terrace West, and Primrose Gardens) are dedicated to seniors who are living independently but prefer some assistance and the community of others. Terrace East is an assisted living apartment building. Menno Home and Menno Hospital provide 24-Hour Residential Care.

340 residents now live in The Apartments in four buildings. All of the buildings have their own kitchen and provide home-cooked meals for the residents. Primrose Gardens is the newest independent living apartment. Built in 2010, it has 105 suites with 8 two bedroom suites.

The Apartments at Menno Place consist of four independent living apartments that are primarily privately paid for in a month-to-month lease. Residents enjoy the amenities of their own building as well as the Chapel (Sunday church service and special events in Menno Hospital), the Fireside Café (Menno Hospital) and the Pharmacy delivery service (medications delivered at lunch).

Residents also enjoy Menno TV, channel that is available site-wide providing original programming. Terrace East and West house a hair salon, wellness center and Fireside Treasures for gifts as well as everyday essential supplies such as milk, eggs, fruit, canned goods and toiletries.

Pastoral care is available from our two chaplains as well as foot care and regular wellness nurse visits. Our knowledgeable staff will help you navigate your way through Fraser Health assessments and Home Health Care if the need for assistance increases.
