

Job Title: Recreation Aide

Menno Place is seeking Recreation Aides with demonstrated ability to fulfil the recreation therapy needs of our residents. The successful candadate will be responsible to:

- 1. Encourage resident participation in individual and group recreational activities related to their needs, abilities and interests which promotes the physical, social, emotional, cognitive, and spiritual needs of the residents. Plan, organize and set up equipment in varies areas; lead and teach related techniques.
- 2. Provide direction to volunteers during recreation programs.
- 3. Provide awareness to residents and family members of special events by means such as posters, use of the bulletin boards in each neighbourhood, resident council monthly meetings, and our website; encourages resident participation.
- 4. Decorate the facility in accordance with recognized holidays such as Christmas, Easter, Remembrance Day, Valentine's Day and St. Patrick's Day.
- 5. Accompany residents on outings such as community events and tours.
- 6. Assist and encourage individual residents with specific needs such as; meals, walking, range of motion, exercises, and one: one visit.
- 7. Transport residents utilizing wheelchairs.
- 8. Observes residents during programs/activities and removes disruptive residents from the area.
- 9. Report any change in residents' condition such as mobility, temperature, skin colour or general condition to the Team Leader of Care or delegate.

- Graduation with a recognized recreation certificate, plus two years' recent related experience or an
 equivalent combination of education, training and experience.
- Current basic First Aid and C.P.R. Training
- Food Safe
- Class 4 Drivers license
